Mayor Jackson called the meeting to order and Councilman Seegars led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Jackson provided the opening prayer.

Consent Agenda:

The minutes for February 2018 were presented. Councilman Benton moved the minutes and financials be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment:

Robert (Bob) Biggers from 100 Wooten Point Road questioned if the Village had an engineer and if so what the engineer had to say regarding the lake and the dam. Mayor Jackson advised that the Village did have an engineer hired. Many studies have been done to determine what flowed through the spillway to understand what happened. The present scenario is not completed but when the study is completed it will be presented. The bid package is being finished.

Administrator/Chief of Police Report:

Administrator/Chief Parchman advised from the TCC the Hwy 70/Beston Rd exchange would start sometime in June 2018. The company handling the camera of the sewer line should call next month. A discussion regarding water billed and water purchased was brought up. Planning on reading water meters April, May and June to compare figures.

Administrator/Chief Parchman presented the Police Report. Residents going over 40 MPH are being given tickets for speeding.

Administrator/Chief Parchman advised the gear Boxes are ordered for \$15,200. Also advised we are still OK under the FEMA allocated money. An extension was requested and Administrator Parchman is still waiting to hear from the State.

Administrator Parchman gave out a Project List in order of Importance. Document following the minutes.

Mayor Pro-Tem Ricker- Water & Sewer, Lake Committee, and Audit:

Mayor Pro-Tem Ricker stated all his items had already been covered.

Councilwoman Dupuy- Village Owned Property and Village Relation:

Councilwoman Dupuy advised date for the Village Picnic has been set for April 28th, 2018. Flood Plain adoption letter should be ready in the next two weeks for adoption of the Council. Chip Crumpler with Wayne County is preparing the letter.

Councilman Benton-Cable TV, Trash & Recycling and Planning Board:

Councilman Benton advised all was quiet with the Cable TV and Trash and Recycling. The Planning Board will be meeting on March 14, 2018. A discussion came up regarding Maynard Price and a trailer being on the annexed property at Village Green. Administrator Parchman was instructed to get pictures and check the Commercial Property Ordinances to determine if Mr. Price is in violation. The resulting information to be presented to the Planning Board.

Councilman John Seegars-Lake Committee, Insurance and Audit Committee

Councilman Seegers advised the Lake Committee did meet in February. Fishing and Lake Rules were discussed. A concern was addressed regarding the new rocks around the boating docks area. It was decided signs might be a better way to handle the hazard instead of buoys. Signs are being secured to place on the weir area and the boat area.


