

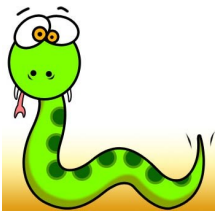

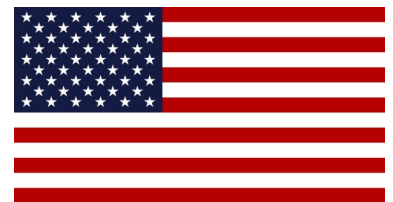
Be on alert school has started and the busses are out! Obey all the rules of the road.
