As we are still in the heart of Hurricane Season; Here is a suggested list of items for an emergency kit:

Water - one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation, Food - at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food, Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert, Flashlight, First aid kit, extra batteries, plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place, Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation, Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities, Manual can opener for food, make sure all cell phones are charged and have a battery operated charger as this will likely be the best form of communication you will have, cash (because if the power goes out you will not be able to access money from the atm and some establishments, if they are open, may only take cash) any medications you may be taking. Please make sure you are taking all precautions to keep yourself and your family safe.

Emergency Spillway Repair: The engineers at Terracon are still working on the design for Phase II of the Emergency Spillway repair. Their design will include mitigation to prevent another erosion issue on the downside of the spillway. It also includes a plan to lower the weir in front of the spillway so should we have another extreme rain event, the spillway will activate sooner. Despite the new designs, given the unpredictability of recent storms we are not able to guarantee homes will not flood. Storms like Irene, Harvey and Irma have shown just how much rain they can drop in a short period of time.

Please be sure you pay your water & sewer bill on time. We bill Quarterly (Jan, April, July & Oct). The bill is due the 1st of the following month & cut off is the 15th. Effective July 1st 2017, the re-connect fee is \$100. Please be sure to pay your bills before the disconnect date.
