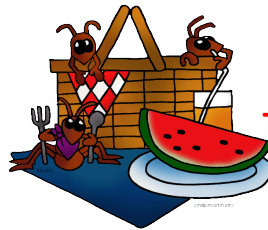




The Village Council will meet in their regular session Wednesday March 28th @7:30PM at the Town Hall—all meetings are open to the public.
