### VERY IMPORTANT

The Village Council approved the following update to  
Chapter 50 Water System January 27, 2021

### § 50.18 WATER RATES AND CHARGES.

(B) Bills for water usage shall be rendered monthly on or about the first Thursday of the month. Failure to make payment by the last Monday of the month shall result in a late fee being added to the outstanding bill. Failure to make full payment of the previous month's bill including the late fee by the 15th of the following month will result in severance of water services. Water service shall not be restored until the person applying for reinstatement has paid the outstanding bill, late fee, & re-connect fee as established by resolution of the Village Council. Additionally, residents who do not have a utility deposit on file and have had their water turned off for non-payment will be required to pay a deposit as established by resolution of the Village Council.



The Village of Walnut Creek Council voted several months ago to no longer accept cash payments in the Village office. We have a new bank & we are able to direct deposit checks & money orders without a trip to the bank. No more driving to Goldsboro and waiting in long lines at the drive up. Effective February 1, 2021 please pay with a check or a money order.

You need current proof of insurance, registration and a completed application (available at the office or online at our website). All documentation must be up-to-date in order to get your boat sticker.

Residents \$50 each for a craft with a motor, \$25 without a motor.
